- learn how to choose the right apps for your child (i.e. Can your child operate the
 equipment? Is it motivating for him? Can you modify the app for your child's individual
 needs?)
- observe demonstrations on how to use (and modify) some popular apps (i.e. how to write letters; matching tasks; songs)
- be provided a list of some current apps and helpful websites
